Dear Parents/ Caregivers,

The Mathematics Teaching Staff of John Paul College have decided to incorporate the online Maths Buddy resource as part of the compulsory teaching program for 2014 for year 7 and 8. This is instead of the Mathematics homework book. The website is designed to provide support to students in their Mathematics learning.

The key features of the Maths Buddy website are:

- 1. Virtual Tutor: An on-screen lesson for different mathematical concepts with a pause/rewind/fast forward facility which allows your child to learn and control the lesson at a pace that suits them or to go over a lesson as many times as they wish.
- 2. <u>Homework setting</u>: Teachers will be setting homework through the Maths Buddy website. The homework will be tailored to your child's ability in Mathematics and all marking of work is done immediately
- 3. Progress reports: Parents can receive automatic weekly reports on their child's programme use and mathematical progress.

Before access is given to any student, the following acknowledgement form must be filled out and returned to Mrs Boyce in the accounts office, with a payment of \$24. An individual login will be given to your child giving them access to the entire Maths Buddy program and its improvements until the end of January 2014. For students who do not have computer access at home, there will be an opportunity to access Maths Buddy in the library during break times and during the homework club run by John Paul College on Monday and Wednesday after school.

Te Ngae Medical Centre would like to welcome all students back to John Paul College for the start of 2014. We wish you all a healthy and happy year.

Te Ngae Medical Centre provides an article each month for the student newsletter and we try to cover health issues that are either relevant in the media at the time or that we feel may be helpful for students. This month's article is about the recent outbreak of measles involving a number of people who attended a dance festival in Sydney. Measles is highly infectious. It is a serious disease and is easily spread to someone who is not immunised, or who has not been exposed to measles previously. People are infectious for five days before symptoms develop and for five days after the onset of a rash.

Immunisation is the single most effective measure someone can take to protect themselves and their family from measles. A publicly funded vaccine is available through General Practice. This is normally given at 15 months of age with a booster at 4yr. The vaccine also provides immunisation against mumps and rubella.

It is very important that anyone who has symptoms of measles seeks medical advice. Symptoms can include fever, runny nose, and sore watery red eyes that last for several days before a red blotchy rash appears. However, because measles can be easily spread, it is also important that you contact the Healthline on 0800 611 116, or ring your doctor first so that the symptoms can be initially assessed without risk of infecting others in a GP waiting room or hospital emergency department.
