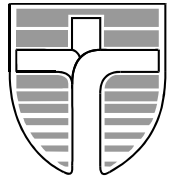

OUTSTANDING NCEA SCHOLARSHIP RESULTS

The College congratulates and salutes the students who achieved scholarship in NCEA last year. It is important to note this is the pinnacle of academic achievement. To achieve a scholarship, a student must be in the top 3% of students sitting the exam and within 1% to achieve an Outstanding Scholarship.

Of particular note is Marc Rigter, who was named one of only twenty students nationally as an Outstanding Scholar since he achieved five scholarships, two at the outstanding level.

Jonathan Cooper, a Year 12 student last year, achieved two scholarships, including in Technology, which is notoriously difficult to do.
