Year 7/8 students require them now. Year 9/10 will require them for Week 5.

The PE uniform for YR 7-11 is the PE black with red T shirt from the uniform shop and black shorts. The shorts must have <u>no stripes</u> down the side and need to have the appropriate leg length. No league shorts and no tights to be worn under the shorts. Students will not be allowed to participate without the correct PE uniform, in half gear or incorrect gear without a note explaining why the student is not in the correct gear.
